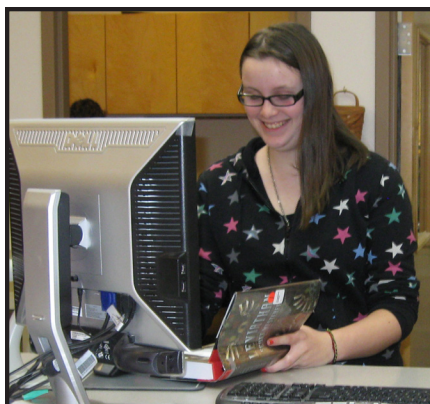
How You Can Help:

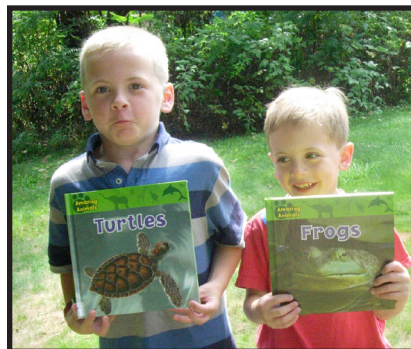
