Opus 40 is comprised of a 6.5-acre walkable sculpture; 0.5 acre meadow; more than 50 acres of walkable trails; and a gallery, museum, gift shop and sitting area.

Here, abandoned quarries are living artwork, quarrying tools are reassembled into sculpture in the Quarryman's Museum, and actors and musicians perform in, on, around and through the park, adapting their performance to the terrain, views and acoustics of the site.

We typically welcome guests in Spring, Summer and Fall, and are available for [educational field trips](#), [guided tours](#) and [weddings](#) all year long. We also host [an eclectic array of events](#), including nature walks led by Audubon educators, art workshops, and live music and theatrical performances — all with the majestic Catskill Mountains as the backdrop.

Each year, 25,000 art, culture and nature enthusiasts from the Hudson Valley, New York City, and throughout the state, country and world visit Opus 40.

**In 2020**, we've been forced to cancel many events and postpone many others, [due to COVID-19](#), but **we are offering limited social distancing visitation**.

## Schedule Your Visit Today

Opus 40 is now open — for **visits of a maximum of two hours**, only, for **groups of five or fewer** — Thursdays to Mondays from 11 AM to 5 PM.

To protect other visitors and our employees, and prevent overcrowding, **you must get tickets in advance**; no one will be allowed entry without prior signup. ***Also please note that we can not refund or transfer visit reservations once they are made.***

*Social distancing* visits are **free** for:

- Opus 40 members
- Essential workers (i.e., hospital employees, police officers, fire fighters, and food distribution and agricultural workers) *(in May/June)*
